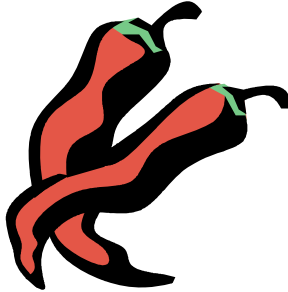


6th Annual Cowboy Cook-off

Make enough food for approximately 50 taste testers. This is about 2 ½ gallons of food. You may prepare it ahead of time and reheat it at the park!

Cash Prizes will be awarded for People's Choice, Judges Choice, and Best Theme. That means it's time to dust off your spurs, because whoever has the best costume and/or table decoration that fits the Pioneer Days theme – "*Community is the Heart of Crawford*" – will win! You must be 18 years old to enter.
