**Pre-registration Requirement: EVERYONE ATTENDING THIS YEAR'S PARADE MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED Prior to June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022!** As done in the past, there is **NO ENTRY FEE**, but if you would like to make a “donation” to help defer parade costs, please include those funds along with your signed/returned Parade Entry Form. All the money we earn this year helps us put this event on the following year! Again, registration **this year** will strictly be done through a Pre-Registration Process. There will be no Registration Table the day of this event. Anyone wishing to participate after we've reached our Pre-Registration cut-off date will be allowed to go to the end of the lineup the day of the event. Our announcements will be brief to keep the flow of the parade route moving quickly. The lineup will be pre-arranged, and each entry will be notified of their placement within a couple days after the June 6<sup>th</sup> Cut-Off date for Pre-Registrations.

## Parade Instructions

*Please follow ALL of these instructions for the safety of participants as well as the spectators.*

**The main parade will require a pre-registration, which will be processed prior to the day of this event.** If you don't have an assigned location, you'll go to the end of the organized parade lineup for a position. Again for 2022...**All entrants MUST submit a completed/signed Pre-registration form to be assigned a location number in the parade line-up. There will be NO REGISTRATION tables again this year!**

The parade route will remain the same as in years past, ending at Hwy 92/H Street. Due to traffic and safety concerns, the RETURN route will go along Elm Street (north of Town Hall) back to the start of the parade. **NO PARADE PARTICIPANT will be allowed to use Cedar Avenue.**

### Please help by following assigned routes.

- Line-up on the parade route in the space assigned during the “Pre-Registration Process”. Make sure to mention your overall length, so an ample space can be provided for your entry.
- Remember that it can get hot, so please have water available for riders and animals. Shade is limited along staging route. A PORTA POTTY will be provided at corner of Dogwood/A Street, near County Building.
- If throwing candy or treats...please be sure to throw these items close enough to the spectators (not at them) to keep children from entering the parade route.
- **No guns, fireworks, revving of engines, horn honking or sudden loud noises allowed NEAR the ANIMALS.** If your presentation includes any of these, **PLEASE** let the Parade Organizers know this at the time of Pre-Registration.
- Parade Entries will not be Judged again this year!
- Please keep the original spacing between entries. There should be approximately 50 feet (length of 3 vehicles) between your float and the next. There will be a Pioneer Days Committee member on the route helping to keep the spacing correct.
- **AGAIN.** Parade ends at the car wash. To return to the starting point, turn right at the car wash, then right onto Elm which will bring you back to the fire station. **DO NOT** turn back through the parade route or onto Cedar Avenue.
- **AGAIN:** A Porta Potty is available at corner of A Street/Dogwood (Front of County Road Building/Fire Station)
